

## Painted Autumn Post It Note Holder Video Tutorial



### Paper

Pear Pizzazz Card stock: Cut 9 1/8" x 7 1/8"

Painted Harvest Designer Series Paper: Cut 2" x 1 1/8"

Painted Harvest Designer Series Paper: Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/8"

Painted Harvest Designer Series Paper: Cut (2) 2" x 2 3/8"

Very Vanilla Card stock: scrap for stamping

Early Espresso Card stock: scrap for cutting

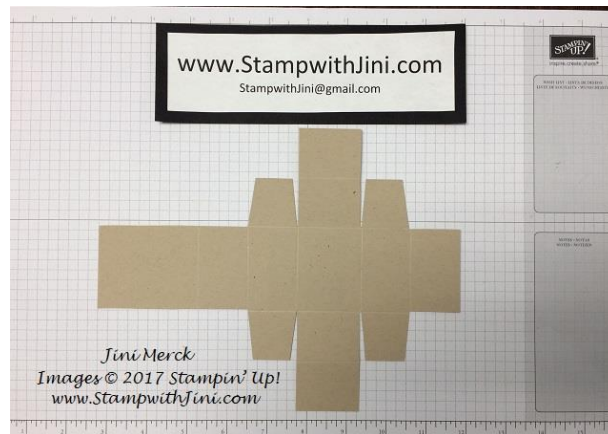

(3) 1 3/8" x 1 7/8" Post it Notes

## Assembly:

1. With the long side against the top of your Simply Scored Scoring Tool – Score at 1 1/4", 2 1/2", 4 1/8", 5 3/8" and 6 5/8".
2. Place short side against top of Simply Scored Scoring Tool and score at the 1 1/4", 2 1/2", 4 5/8", 5 7/8".
3. Cut on score lines as shown and trim down flaps for easier folding.



4. Fold on score lines and assemble as shown in the Painted Autumn Post It Note Holder Video Tutorial using your favorite adhesive.
5. Adhere 3 pieces of Painted Autumn Designer Series Pieces to the sides of box.
6. Then add the 2 Painted Autumn Designer Series Paper pieces to the back section on both the front and back of the box.
7. Now stamp the sentiment in Early Espresso Classic Ink onto Very Vanilla Card stock.
8. Cut out the sentiment using the Layering Oval Framelits Die and the Big Shot.
9. Cut a scallop oval from Early Espresso Card stock using the Layering Oval Framelits Die and the Big Shot.
10. Layer the sentiment onto Early Espresso scallop oval piece. And adhere to box on the top of the back area.
11. Using the 1" Circle Punch add a finger grip to the front panel of the box using about 1/2 of the circle. (I've simply pushed the punch in until the front of the punch touched the bottom of the box.)
12. Add 3 1 3/8" x 1 7/8" Post It Note pads.
