Always Artichoke Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "; scored at 4 1/4" and folded

Crushed Curry Card stock: Cut 3" x 5 1/2"
Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 2 3/4" x 5 1/2"
Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"
Very Vanilla Card stock: scrap for stamping
Regals Enamel Shapes: 1 Crushed Curry circle

Assembly:

- 1. See my Tips for Using the Painted Harvest Stamp Set Video Tutorial for tips on lining up your flowers.
- 2. Cut out scalloped oval shape using the Layering Ovals Framelits Die from the center of the Crushed Curry Card stock piece. Making sure you don't get close to the edges. (The Very Vanilla layer will hide the holes.) Set aside for step 11.
- 3. Then adhere Crushed Curry Card stock piece to the card front about 1/4" from the left-hand edge.
- 4. Stamp the flower randomly onto the Very Vanilla Card stock piece 3 times using Fresh Fig Classic Ink, making sure to turn the stamp for each one so they don't all look the same. First using the larger flower and then a second time using the smaller image. (You can stamp off the larger image to create another softer shade if desired.)
- 5. Next stamp the center of the flowers using Crushed Curry Classic Ink.
- 6. Add the little dots to the center of each flower using Fresh Fig Classic Ink.
- 7. Then stamp the leaf image randomly using Always Artichoke Classic Ink stamping off for the solid image and then full strength for the veined image.
- 8. Adhere piece to card front.
- 9. Stamp the sentiment in Fresh Fig Classic Ink onto Whisper White Card stock.
- 10. Cut out the sentiment using the Layering Oval Framelits Die and the Big Shot.
- 11. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to layer the sentiment onto scallop oval piece.
- 12. Then adhere sentiment card stock to card front slightly to the right side.
- 13. Finally add a Crushed Curry Enamel Shape Circle as desired on the sentiment piece.
- 14. Stamp a flower or leaf image and sentiment to the Very Vanilla inside panel and adhere.
- 15. Stamp the envelope as desired.
