Paper

Very Vanilla Thick Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4" and folded

Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Crumb Cake Card stock: Cut 3 1/4" x 1 1/4"

Crushed Curry Solid Baker's Twine: Cut 26-28"

Painted Harvest Thank You Card:

Assembly:

- 1. See my Tips for Using the Painted Harvest Stamp Set Video Tutorial for tips on lining up your flowers.**
2. Stamp the flower randomly onto the Very Vanilla Card stock piece 3 times using Daffodil Delight and Crushed Curry Classic Ink, making sure to turn the stamp for each one so they don't all look the same. First using the larger flower and then a second time using the smaller image. (You can stamp off the larger image to create another softer shade if desired.)
3. Next stamp the center of the flowers using Early Espresso Classic Ink.
4. Add the little dots to the center of each flower using Fresh Early Espresso Ink.
5. Then stamp the leaf image randomly using Garden Green Classic Ink stamping off for the solid image and then full strength for the veined image.
6. Stamp acorns around flowers using Crumb Cake for the bottom and Early Espresso for the tops.
7. Then using Crumb Cake stamp dots image around card front stamping off to create different shades.
8. Wrap Crushed Curry Solid Baker's Twine around card twice and tie into a bow.
9. Adhere piece to card front.
10. Now stamp the sentiment in Garden Green Classic Ink onto Crumb Cake Card stock.
11. Punch the right end of the Crumb Cake sentiment piece using the Triple Banner Punch to create a flag.
12. Add sentiment to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
13. Stamp a flower or leaf image and sentiment to the Very Vanilla inside panel and adhere.
14. Stamp the envelope as desired.
