Island Indigo Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 5 1/2"

Smoky Slate Card stock: Cut 2 1/2" x 4 1/4"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 2 1/4" x 4 1/4"

Smoky Slate Card stock: Cut 3" x 2 3/4"

Island Indigo Card stock: 2 3/4" x 2 1/2"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 2 1/2" x 2 1/4"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

Feather Together Card Tutorial

Assembly:

1. Adhere Smoky Slate card stock to card front about 1/4" from left side.
2. Stamp feathers randomly onto Whisper White card stock using Basic Black for the outline image, Smoky Slate for the larger feathers and Island Indigo for the smaller feathers. Adhere to Smoky Slate layer on card front.
3. Adhere the Smoky Slate card stock piece about 1/2" down from the top in center of card front.
4. Using Basic Black Archival Ink stamp the goose image onto Whisper White card stock.
5. Using the Aqua Painter and Island Indigo color the overalls.
6. Using the Aqua Painter and the Smoky Slate add some color to the geese.
7. Adhere the image onto the Island Indigo card stock piece.
8. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back and adhere layered piece to Smoky Slate layer on the card front.
9. Stamp the inside Whisper White panel as desired and adhere.
10. Stamp the envelope as desired.
