Soft Suede Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 5 1/2" Basic Black Card stock: Cut 2 1/2" x 4 1/4" Cherry Cobbler Card stock: Cut 2 1/4" x 4 1/4" Basic Black Card stock: 3 3/4" x 3" Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 3 1/2" x 2 3/4" Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

Heartland Card Tutorial

Assembly:

- 1. Adhere Basic Black card stock to card front about 1/4" from left side.
- 2. Run Cherry Cobbler Card stock through the Big Shot using the Pinewood Planks Embossing Folder. Then adhere to Basic Black piece on the card front.
- 3. Using Early Espresso Classic Ink stamp the barn onto Very Vanilla card stock.
- 4. Adhere the image onto the Basic Black card stock piece.
- 5. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back and adhere layered piece to card front about 1/2" down from the top.
- 6. Stamp the inside Very Vanilla panel as desired and adhere.
- 7. Stamp the envelope as desired.
