Powder Pink Card stock (144244): Cut 6 1/2" x 1"

Sweet Soiree Specialty Designer Series Paper (145564): Cut 6 1/2" x 3/4"

Whisper White (100730): scrap for die cutting

Whisper White (100730): 3" x ½"

Sweet Soiree Specialty Designer Series Paper (145564): Scrap for punching

## **Punch Bunny Sweet Soiree Treat Tent Tutorial Continued:**

### **Assembly:**

You can refer to my Painted with Love Treat Tent Video Tutorial on my YouTube channel for assembly instructions.

1. Line the short side of Marina Mist Card stock up along the top ruler of your Simply Scored Scoring Tool and score at the 1", 2 ¼" and 3 ½".
2. Decorate your panel by adhere the Powder Pink stock piece to the second scored area from the bottom.
3. Next adhere the Sweet Soiree Specialty Designer Series Paper to the top of the Powder Pink card stock.
4. Cut a shape using the Cookie Builder Punch.
5. Snip off the arms and cut a V into the legs to separate ears as shown.
6. Using an Aqua Painter and Powder Pink Classic Ink add color to the bunny's ears.
7. Stamp the face on the bunny using the Cook Cutter Christmas stamp and Basic Black Archival Ink.
8. Punch out a bow from the Sweet Soiree Specialty Designer Series Paper and attach to bunny's face using Multipurpose Adhesive. Allow to dry.
9. Add whiskers with a Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker.
10. Finally sponge the edges of the bunny with Smoky Slate Classic Ink to help him pop.
11. Stamp the sentiment in Marina Mist Classic Ink on Whisper White card stock.
12. Punch out the end of the sentiment piece using the Banner Triple Punch. Trim length if needed. Use Multipurpose Adhesive to adhere to the holder. Allow to dry.
13. Add sentiment and completed bunny to holder on left side.
14. Add Fast Fuse to top panel on the inside and adhere to create a triangle.
15. Slide Lindt chocolate bar into treat tent.
