

## Brusho Baby Wipe Technique Card - #OnStage-Atlanta Swap



### Paper

Flirty Flamingo Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Early Espresso Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Shimmer White Card stock: Cut 5" x 3 3/4"

Whisper White Card stock: 4" x 3/4"

Early Espresso Card stock: 4 1/4" x 1/2"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

## Brusho Baby Wipe Technique Card –

### Assembly:

1. Adhere the Early Espresso Card stock piece to the card front.
2. Stamp your butterfly image onto finished technique panel using Early Espresso Classic Ink. (You're Stamparatus is wonderful for this kind of thing since the Shimmery White card stock may have some buckling to it after using the water since you can stamp again without problems lining it up.)
3. Adhere the finished panel to card front.
4. Stamp sentiment in Early Espresso Classic Ink onto Whisper White Card stock piece.
5. Then take the Triple Banner Punch and punch the end of the sentiment and Early Espresso card stock strip.
6. Layer the Early espresso piece behind the sentiment leave a bit showing.
7. Trim as desired and adhere to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
