Flirty Flamingo Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Basic Black Card stock: Cut 5 3/8" x 4 1/8"

Glossy White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Basic Rhinestone Jewels: 5 small

Brusho Saran Wrap Technique Card

Assembly:

1. Adhere the Basic Black Card stock piece to the card front.
2. Stamp your butterfly image onto finished technique panels lower right-hand corner using Basic Black Archival Ink. (You're Stamparatus is wonderful for this kind of thing since the technique creates some texture and you can stamp again without problems lining it up.)
3. Stamp your sentiment using Basic Black Archival Ink in upper left-hand corner.
4. Adhere the finished panel to card front.
5. Add Rhinestones to the body of the butterfly and on each side of the sentiment as shown.
6. Stamp inside panel as desired and adhere inside card.
7. Stamp envelope as desired.
