

## Truly Tailored Merci Chocolate Box Tutorial



### Paper

Chocolate Chip Card stock: Cut 3 3/4" x 10 1/8"

Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 2 7/8" x 2 5/8"

True Gentleman Designer Series Paper: Cut 2 3/4" x 2 1/2"

Very Vanilla Card stock: scrap for die cut and stamping

## Assembly:

Watch the Petal Palette Merci Chocolate Box Video Tutorial on YouTube for box assembly

1. Place the shorter side of Chocolate Chip Card stock at score at  $3/8$ " and  $3 3/8$ ", then turn it and score at  $3 1/8$ ",  $3 1/2$ ",  $6 5/8$ " and 7"
2. Fold on the score lines and using Paper Snips remove card stock along the two sides as shown on the video tutorial.
3. Punch a hole out using the Tailored Tag Punch so that the chocolates show.
4. Finish assembling box according the video tutorial.
5. Slip Merci chocolates into the box for stability.
6. To decorate box front, adhere Very Vanilla card stock piece.
7. Adhere True Gentleman Designer Series Paper onto Very Vanilla layer.
8. To create the focal piece. Use your Night of Navy, Crushed Curry and Tranquil Tide Stampin' Write markers to color the image. Breath to remoisten ink and stamp onto Very Vanilla card stock.
9. Punch out sentiment using the Tailored Tag Punch.
10. Attach to box front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Place a small Velcro dot circle (I cut mine in half) to the inside of box below the cut out.
12. Close the flap down adhere dot to the inside of flap and to secure closed.
13. You're ready to share and make someone special smile!
