- 1. Using the Simply Scored Tool place the Chocolate Chip Card stock with the long edge at the top and score at the 1 3/8", 1 7/8", 3 ¼" and 3 ½" marks.
- 2. Fold the card stock on the score lines.
- 3. Fold the wrap as shown on the video so that you can see where to apply Designer Series Paper.
- 4. Adhere the True Gentlemen Designer Series Paper to the large 3 ¼" area on the end of the Chocolate Chip piece.
- 5. Turn over the Chocolate Chip piece and look for the second larger (not the ½" area) up from the bottom see video for location.
- 6. Then adhere the True Gentlemen Designer Series Paper to the Chocolate Chip piece.
- 7. Fold into wrap and adhere together using Multipurpose Adhesive. Keeping your edges straight and your box level.
- 8. To create the multi colored sentiment color your sentiment first with the Tranquil Tide Stampin' Write Marker and then with Night of Navy. Breath on it to reactivate the ink and stamp onto Very Vanilla Card stock.
- 9. Next punch the sentiment out using the Tailored Tag Punch.
- 10. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the punched piece and adhere to wrap topper.
- 11. Slide in 3 Hershey's Nuggets and give to someone special!
