Easel Card tutorial

Supplies:

Simply Scored Board Bone Folder Tear & Tape or Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive

1. Pre-fold all score lines. First fold on the 2 ¾" line and then the 5 ½" score line in opposite direction.



2. Place two lines of Tear & Tape on the longer edge of the 2 ¾" section as shown.



3. Adhere the second piece of card stock to the first, lining up the short edges. This creates the easel card base.



For Easel Card Base, you'll need:

Card stock: Cut 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11"; scored at 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Card stock: Cut 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"

4. Decorate as desired.



Tip: To make the easel card stand up an embellishment or layer must be added to the inside of card. It is best to have the layer/embellishment at least one third into the card (from the bottom).
