

Falling for Leaves Treat Tent Video Tutorial



Paper

Merry Merlot Card stock: Cut 4 1/4" x 11"; scored at 1", 5 1/2" and 10"

Joyous Noel Glimmer Paper (copper): Cut 4 1/4" x 1/2"

Shimmery White Card stock: Cut 4 1/4" x 3"

Tea Room Ribbon Combo Pack (Very Vanilla/Copper): Cut 10-12"

Assembly:

1. Fill your Stampin' Spritzer with water and spritz Shimmery White card stock.
2. Sprinkle the yellow and gamboge Brusho Crystal Colours. Spritz with water again.
3. Allow to dry.
4. Use the Stampin' Spritzer to spritz the bottom right hand corner of the Very Vanilla card stock piece to create a hint of shimmer. Allow to dry.
5. Stamp leaf image in the top left-hand corner in Merry Merlot Classic Ink.
6. Then stamp sentiment below on the bottom left-hand corner using Merry Merlot Classic Ink.
7. Fold the Merry Merlot card stock piece in half and use the Pretty Label Punch to punch a hole in the center of card stock. (see video)
8. Adhere the two copper strips to the front of the tent about ¼" up from the bottom and about ½" down from the top.
9. Adhere finished focal point to tent front using Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive.
10. Allow to dry well.
11. Fill Gusseted Cello Bag with candy and gather top. Slip it through the hole on the tent. (I use a cloths pin to hold it close.)
12. Wrap your ribbon around the top of the filled bag and tie in a bow. Trim ends as desired.
13. Add Tear & Tape along the bottom of the back flap along the outside of the tent. Remove protective covering.
14. Place the front flap on top of the back flap and adhere.

Tip: The Glimmer Paper has an intense texture so the Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive allows the card stock to adhere a bit better than the Snail.
