

Harvest Takeout Treat Video Tutorial

Soft Suede Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"
Crushed Curry Card stock: scraps for punching
Joyous Noel Glimmer Paper: scraps for punching
Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 4" x 3/4"

Assembly:

1. Run Soft Suede card stock through the Big Shot with the Takeout Treats Die. Repeat for the second piece.
2. Using the Bone Folder fold on the score lines.
3. Lay the Tree Rings Background stamp on its back and ink up with Soft Suede Classic Ink.
4. Lay the piece of Soft Suede card stock onto the stamp and place a piece of scrap paper on the top. Rub over image. (See Video tutorial).
5. Repeat with the second piece of the box.
6. Place Tear & Tape Adhesive on flaps and build the Takeout Treat Box.
7. Stamp the sentiment onto Very Vanilla card stock piece and run through the Big Shot using the Banner Die.
8. Stamp 2 leaves onto Crushed Curry Card stock using the Crushed Curry Classic Ink.
9. Punch out the 2 leaves and set aside for step 13.
10. Punch out two sprigs using the Merry Merlot Glimmer Paper and the Sprig Punch.
11. Snip one of the sprigs apart.
12. Using the Multipurpose Liquid Glue attach sprigs to box.
13. Add Mini Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the leaves and add to the box.
14. Fold the banner on the score lines, add Mini Glue Dots and add to the box.
15. Fill with your favorite treat and give it to someone special!
