Highland Heather Card stock: Cut 5 ½" x 8 ½"; scored at 4 ¼"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 5" x 3 3/4"

Highland Heather Card stock: Cut 3 3/8" X 2 ¼" Whisper White Card stock: Cut 3 3/8" X 2 ¼"

Crumb Cake Card stock: Cut 1" x 3"
Powder Pink Card stock: Cut 2" x 2"
Whisper White Card stock: Cut 2" x 2"
Whisper White Card stock: Cut 5 ¼" x 4"

# Assembly:

- 1. Stamp the Bokeh Dots image onto Whisper White Card stock.
- 2. Using Paper Snips trim along images edges.
- 3. Adhere Bokeh Dots image onto Highland Heather Card stock.
- 4. Adhere Whisper White card stock panel to the card front.
- 5. Adhere layered Highland Heather image onto the center of card front, leaving a little more of the Whisper White showing below it.
- 6. Stamp the cupcake holder in Coastal Cabana Classic Ink onto Whisper White card stock.
- 7. Stamp the cupcake piece using Crumb Cake Classic Ink.
- 8. Cut out cupcake liner/cupcake piece using Paper Snips.
- 9. Stamp the cupcake icing image in Powder Pink Classic Ink onto Powder Pink Card stock.
- 10. Cut out icing piece using Paper Snips.
- 11. Stamp the sentiment onto Crumb Cake Card stock using Soft Suede Classic ink.
- 12. Using your Paper Snips cut end of card stock at an angle as shown in photo.
- 13. Adhere the cupcake to the left of the sentiment.
- 14. Adhere the frosting to the cupcake. (I like to use Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive).
- 15. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the cupcake/sentiment piece and place onto the card front.
- 16. Stamp the panel for the inside of the card as desired and adhere.
- 17. Stamp the envelope as desired.
