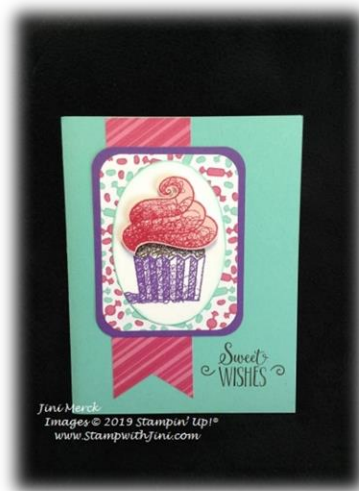


## Hello Cupcake Sweet Treats Card Tutorial



### Paper

Coastal Cabana Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

How Sweet It Is Designer Series Paper (stripes pattern): Cut 1 1/2" x 4"

Gorgeous Grape Card stock: 2 3/4" X 3 1/2"

How Sweet It Is Designer Series paper (candy pattern): Cut 2 1/2" x 3 1/4"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"

Bushing Bride Card stock: scrap for stamping

## Hello Cupcake Sweet Treat Card Tutorial

### Assembly:

1. Stamp sentiment in the lower right-hand corner of the card with Early Espresso Classic Ink.
2. Punch one end of the striped How Sweet It Is Designer Series Paper using the Triple Banner Punch. Cut in half and adhere to card.
3. Punch all four corners of the Gorgeous Grape Card stock and How Sweet It Is Designer Series Paper pieces.
4. Adhere the Gorgeous Grape piece of card stock to the card front.
5. Then adhere the How Sweet It Is Designer Series Paper to the Gorgeous Grape layer.
6. Stamp the cupcake holder in Gorgeous Grape Classic Ink onto Whisper White card stock.
7. Stamp the cupcake piece using Early Espresso Classic Ink.
8. Stamp the cupcake icing image in Melon Mambo Classic Ink.
9. Stamp the cupcake icing again using Melon Mambo Classic Ink onto a piece of Blushing Bride Card stock.
10. Cut out cupcake using the Layering Ovals Die.
11. Cut out the frosting either using the Framelits Dies or Paper Snips.
12. Using a Stampin' Sponge add color to the edge of the oval using the Coastal Cabana Classic Ink Pad.
13. Adhere the cupcake piece to the card front.
14. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back and adhere the frosting onto the cupcake on the card front.
15. Stamp the inside of the card as desired.
16. Stamp the envelope as desired.
