Granny Apple Green Card stock: Cut 3" x 1" Melon Mambo Card stock: Cut 3" x 1" Whisper White Card stock: Cut 3" x 2 3/4" Whisper White Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

Adhesives

Snail (104332/104331) Stampin' Dimensionals (104430) Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive (110755) or Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Assembly:

- 1. Ink up the lily pad line image using the Bermuda Bay Classic Ink and stamp onto a piece of Whisper White Card stock.
- 2. Clean stamp using your Simply Shammy and flip it over reapplying it to the Clear Block.
- 3. Ink up the sold image using Bermuda Bay Classic Ink. Stamp Off once and then stamp onto line image. (The solid image does not match exactly).
- 4. Run your Embossing Buddy over the piece of Melon Mambo Card stock.
- 5. Ink up your Happy Birthday sentiment using VersaMark and stamp on the right side of the card stock.
- 6. Pour some of the White Embossing Powder over it and tap off excess.
- 7. Heat Set the sentiment using the Heat Tool. Allow to cool.
- 8. Run your lily pad image through your die cutting machine using the coordinating Die form the Lily Pad Dies. Set aside for step 13.
- 9. Run a piece of Granny Apple Green Card stock through your die cutting machine using the trim die from the Lily Pad Dies. Set aside for step 12.
- 10. Adhere the Lily Impressions Designer Series Paper the Bermuda Bay Card stock piece.
- 11. Add the layered panel to the card front.
- 12. Add a little bit of adhesive to the trim piece and adhere the sentiment piece to the top allowing only the little scallop trim to show.
- 13. Adhere the lily pad image to the left of the sentiment. Allow the layered focal piece to dry.
- 14. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the layered piece and adhere to the card front. (This will help hold the trim and lily pad in place also).
- 15. Add 3 Coastal Cabana Holiday Rhinestones randomly around the sentiment and flower.
- 16. Stamp sentiment for the inside of the card using Bermuda Bay Classic Ink onto Whisper White panel and adhere to the inside of the card.
- 17. Stamp the envelope as desired.
