Crushed Curry Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"
Early Espresso Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"
Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 3 3/4" x 5"
Early Espresso Card stock: 1/2" x 5"
Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

Painted Harvest (144783)
Seaside Notions (149278)

Layering Ovals Dies (151771)

## Paper

Crushed Curry Card stock (131199)
Early Espresso Card stock (119686)
Very Vanilla Card stock (101650)

## Ink

Pumpkin Pie Ink Pad (147086/105229)
Crushed Curry Classic Ink Pad (131173/131158)
Early Espresso Classic Ink Pad (126974/119789)

1. Stamp the large flower randomly onto the Very Vanilla Card stock piece 5 times using the largest flower image and Crushed Curry Classic Ink, making sure to turn the stamp for each one so they don't all look the same.
2. Then stamp the large flower randomly onto the Crushed Curry ones from step 1 using Pumpkin Pie Classic Ink. Making sure to turn the image slightly so the flower looks fuller.
3. Then stamp smaller flower image using Pumpkin Pie Classic Ink.
4. After stamp the smaller flower in Cajun Craze Classic Ink. Making sure to turn the image slightly so the flower looks fuller.
5. Now stamp the center of the flowers using Early Espresso Classic Ink.
6. Adhere piece to card front.
7. Add the Early Espresso strip of card stock down the center of the flower layer.
8. Stamp the sentiment in Early Espresso Classic Ink onto Very Vanilla Card stock.
9. Cut out the sentiment using the Layering Oval Framelits Die and the Big Shot.
10. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to layer the sentiment onto scallop oval piece.
11. Then adhere sentiment card stock to card front.
12. Stamp a flower or leaf image and sentiment to the Very Vanilla inside panel and adhere as desired.
13. Stamp the envelope as desired.
