Continued:

- 1. Stamp the small dragonfly group image using Bumblebee Classic Ink along the left edge of the of the Basic White Card stock panel as shown.
- 2. Stamp the sentiment in the using Misty Moonlight Classic Ink on the lower right-hand corner of the Basic White Card stock panel.
- 3. Add the longer strip of stripped Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper about 13/4" up from the bottom edge of the sentiment panel.
- 4. Adhere the layered panel to the card front.
- 5. Place Stampin' Dimensionals onto the back of the two remaining strips of Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper.
- 6. Adhere the first strip onto the card front along the bottom and the second strip along the top of the stripped piece. Make sure to leave a bit of the stripe pattern showing.
- 7. Using Bumblebee Classic Ink stamp the wing image twice on the Bumblebee card stock panel to create a shadow for the dragonfly.
- 8. Adhere the Bumblebee Card stock panel to center of the popped-up strips as shown. Making sure to apply adhesive only along the top and bottom edges.
- 9. Punch a dragonfly out using a piece of the Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper with the Dragonflies Punch. (See punching tip below)
- 10. Add a Stampin' Dimensional to the back of the wings and then adhere onto the card front so that the dragonfly is hovering over the wings shadow.
- 11. Stamp inside Basic White panel using the dragonfly image and Bumblebee Classic Ink in the upper left-hand corner.
- 12. Stamp envelope as desired.
