Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper (pattern 2): Cut 3 1/4" x 1 1/4" Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper (pattern 3): Cut 3 1/4" x 1 1/4"

Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper: piece for punching

Basic White Card stock: Cut 4 " x 5 1/4"

# **Dragonfly Garden Card #3**

### Continued:

- 1. Stamp the wild flower image using Bumblebee Classic Ink in the center and then on each side of the first image of the Basic White Card stock panel as shown.
- 2. Stamp the sentiment in the using Misty Moonlight Classic Ink on the center of the Bumblebee Card stock panel.
- 3. Adhere the stamped panel to the card front.
- 4. Add the longer strip of stripped Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper about 3/4" up from the bottom of the left side, lining it up with the edge of the card stock.
- 5. Place Stampin' Dimensionals onto the back of the two remaining strips of Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper.
- 6. Adhere the first strip onto the card front along the bottom and the second strip along the top of the stripped piece from step #4 as shown. Make sure to leave a bit of the stripe pattern showing.
- 7. Adhere the sentiment panel to center of the popped-up strips as shown. Making sure to apply adhesive only along the top and bottom edges.
- 8. Punch a dragonfly out using a piece of the Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper with the Dragonflies Punch. (See punching diagram below)
- 9. Add a Stampin' Dimensional to the back of the right wing and some adhesive onto the left wing then adhere onto the card front so that the dragonfly is the same height as the sentiment layer.
- 10. Stamp inside Basic White panel on the lower right-hand corner using the Bumblebee Classic Ink and your wildflower image.
- 11. Stamp envelope as desired.
