Continued:

- 1. Stamp the dragonfly image in the using Misty Moonlight Classic Ink on the Basic White Card stock panel randomly.
- 2. Stamp the wing image using Bumblebee Classic Ink onto each dragonfly. First on the right and then turning it upside down to do the ones on the left. (The wings are not a perfect match; it is designed that way).
- 3. Using Misty Moonlight Classic Ink stamp the sentiment along the bottom of the Bumblebee Card stock panel.
- 4. Then using Bumblebee Classic Ink stamp the wing image twice above the sentiment at an angle on the Bumblebee card stock panel to create a shadow for the dragonfly.
- 5. Adhere the longer strip of stripped Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper about 1 1/2" up from the bottom edge of the stamped panel.
- 6. Adhere the layered panel to the card front.
- 7. Place Stampin' Dimensionals onto the back of the two remaining strips of Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper.
- 8. Adhere the first strip onto the card front on the right edge leaving about 1/4" from the edge of the stamped panel edge.
- 9. Adhere the second strip to the left of the right piece leaving some of the stripe pattern showing.
- 10. Adhere the Bumblebee Card stock panel to center of the popped-up strips as shown. Making sure to apply adhesive only along the left and right edges.
- 11. Punch a dragonfly out using a piece of the Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper with the Dragonflies Punch. (See punching tip below)
- 12. Add a Stampin' Dimensional to the back of the wings and then adhere onto the card front so that the dragonfly is hovering over the wings shadow.
- 13. Stamp inside Basic White panel using the wildflower image and Bumblebee Classic Ink in the left-hand corner.
- 14. Stamp envelope as desired.
