

## Best of Saleabration Pop Up Gift Card Holder

Gumball Green Classic Ink (item 126861)  
2012-2014 In Color Stampin' Write Markers (item 126856)  
Envelope Punch Board (item 133774)  
Simply Scored Scoring Tool (item 122334)  
1 3/8" Circle Punch (item 119860)  
1 3/4" Scallop Circle Punch (item 119854)  
Paper-Piercing Tool (item 126189)  
Stampin' Pierce Mat (item 126199)  
Stampin' Sponges (item 101610)  
Stampin' Dimensionals (item 104430)  
Bone Folder (item 102300)  
Sticky Strip (item 104294)



Summer Starfruit Card Stock (item 126839): 4 1/4" x 11"; scored at 2", 7 1/4", and 7 3/8"  
Birthday Basics Designer Series Paper (item 130145): 4" x 3"  
Raspberry Ripple Card Stock (item 126842): scrap for punching  
Very Vanilla Card Stock (item 101650): scrap for punching  
Raspberry Ripple Satin Stitched Ribbon (item 126845): 16"  
Very Vanilla Card Stock (item 101650): 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"; scored at 1/2" and 4 3/4"  
Birthday Basics Designer Series Paper (item 130145): 3 1/2" x 1/2" and 3 1/2" x 1 3/4"

1. Place the long edge of Summer Starfruit card stock on Simply Scoring Tool and score at 2", 7 1/4", and 7 3/8". Fold on score lines using Bone Folder.
2. Using the Envelope Punch Board place the larger flap at the 1" mark and punch. Flip over and repeat on the other side. (See my Pop Up Gift Card Holder Video Tutorial for detailed instructions).
3. Adhere Birthday Basics Designer Series Paper to top flap.
4. Punch out a 1 3/4" Scallop Circle from Raspberry Ripple Card Stock. Pierce scallops using the Paper Piercer Tool and Stampin' Pierce Mat.
5. Stamp flower image using Gumball Green and Raspberry Ripple Stampin' Write Markers. Punch out image with 1 3/8" Circle Punch. Using a Stampin' Sponge, sponge edges of circle with Gumball Green ink. Attach to Scallop Circle using a Stampin' Dimensional. Then adhere onto the center of the Designer Series Paper.
6. Wrap a piece of Raspberry Ripple Satin Stitched Ribbon around the bottom flap and tie a knot. Trim ends.
7. Place your Very Vanilla Card Stock with long edge along the top, score at the 1/2" and 4 3/4" marks. Fold on score lines.
8. Adhere the Birthday Basics Designer Series Paper to both the top section and the bottom section, (making sure to adhere to the correct sides.) Sponge all your edges in Gumball Green ink.
9. Stamp the "Happy Birthday" sentiment in Gumball Green.
10. Add a piece of Sticky Strip along the top edge. Slide folded piece into pocket until just a sliver of the Designer Series Paper shows. Fold down top flap and remove protective strip from Sticky Strip. Close the top of Summer Starfruit base on to Sticky Strip. (See my Pop Up Gift Card Holder Video Tutorial for detailed instructions).
11. Add gift card and tuck in flap to close.
