Cherry Cobbler Card Stock (item 119685): 9 3/4" x 3 1/2"

Trim the Tree Designer Series Paper Stack (item 135824): 3 1/4" x 2 3/4"

Night of Navy Card Stock (item 100867): 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Night of Navy Card Stock (item 100867): 8 ½" x ½" and scrap piece for punching

Cherry Cobbler Card Stock (item 119685): 2 1/4" x 3 1/4"

Whisper White Card Stock (item 100730): 2" x 3" and scrap piece for Framelit

- 1. Take the piece of Cherry Cobber CS and score it at the 3" and 3 1/4".
- 2. Place the larger part of the Cherry CS into the Northern Flurry Embossing folder, run through the big shot.
- 3. Stamp your sentiment in Versa Mark Ink onto the largest part of treat holder. Sprinkle with White Embossing Powder and heat using the Heat Tool.
- 4. Attach the Trim the Tree Designer Series Paper to the bottom section of the Cherry Cobbler piece. Fold along score lines.
- 5. Score your Night of Navy belly band at the 3", 3 ¼", 6 ¾", and 7" mark. Fold on score lines.
- 6. Place cocoa packet into treat base (for stability) and wrap belly band around treat base.
- 7. Place a line of adhesive onto both belly band ends and adhere.
- 8. Punch a 1 3/4" circle from Night of Navy card stock and adhere to belly band covering the ends. (This will give you a bigger base to hold the focal point you create in the next step.)
- 9. Next, take a Whisper White piece of card stock and stamp your Nutcracker image in Memento tuxedo black Ink.
- 10. Color the Nutcracker using your Cherry Cobbler, Night of Navy, and Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blendabilities Markers and the face using your choice of Skin Tone Stampin' Blendabilities Markers.
- 11. Stamp your mustache image onto a scrap piece of Whisper White using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
- 12. Cut the mustache out using your Mustache Framelits Die. Add your mustache to Nutcracker image using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 13. Add the Nutcracker image to the Cherry Cobbler layer, and then Night of Navy layer to create your focal point. Adhere onto circle.
