

## Season Like Christmas Card (Masking Technique)



### Paper

Thick Whisper White Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4" and folded

Real Red Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 4 3/4" x 3 1/2"

Whisper White card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

#### Stamps

#### Paper

Thick Whisper White Card stock (144237)

Real Red Card Stock (102482)

Whisper White Card stock (100730)

#### Ink

Soft Sky Ink Pad (131181)

Wild Wasabi Classic Ink Pad (126959)

Garden Green Classic Ink Pad (126973)

Chocolate Chip Classic Ink (126979)

Real Red Classic Ink (126949)

#### Accessories

Stampin' Sponges (141337)

Large Sticky Notes

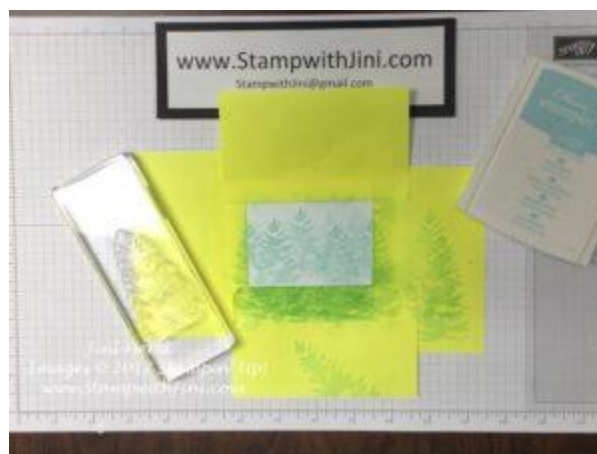
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### Assembly:

1. Take some large post it notes and create a frame on the card front. I used my grid paper to make sure the lines were straight. I simply laid my card stock down on the grid paper, used a ruler counting 2 squares down (or 1/2") then stuck the sticky note down. (The grid lines make lining things up easy and keeps everything straight.)



2. Use a Stampin' Sponge and Soft Sky Classic Ink to lightly sponged the area inside the sticky notes on the card front.



3. Next stamp the tree image using the Soft Sky Classic Ink. First towards the bottom of the card stock and then again higher up to create different shades of trees. Repeat to fill the space as desired.

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### Assembly Continued:

4. Removed the sticky notes and stamped the tree in Wild Wasabi and Garden Green Classic Ink.
5. Stamp the “full” tree image using Wild Wasabi Classic Ink.
6. Then stamp the two-step tree using Garden Green Classic Ink.
7. Finally add the tree trunk to your tree using Chocolate Chip Classic Ink.
8. Stamp sentiment desired in Real Red Classic Ink.
9. Adhere finished card front to Real Red Card stock piece.
10. Add Stampin’ Dimensionals to the back of the Real Red card stock and adhere to the card front.
11. Stamp inside with sentiment using Real Red Classic Ink.
12. Stamp the envelope as desired.
