Assembly:

- Take about 1 cup of Corn Cobb bedding and place into zip lock bag. Add about 10-15 drops of Lavender Essential Oil. Shake and allow to sit. Add more essential oil if desired.
- 2. Using the Envelope Punch Board create a 3x4 Envelope.
- 3. Adhere the envelope together and fill with a tablespoon of scented corn cobb filling. Seal the envelope.
- 4. Loop a piece of the Berry Burst ½" Finely Woven Ribbon around the envelope.
- 5. Then take a piece of Whisper White Solid Baker's Twine and tie it around the two ends. Tie a bow and trim as desired.
- 6. Now stamp your image onto a piece of Whisper White Card stock using Basic Gray Archival Ink.
- 7. Next stamp the lavender flowers in Berry Burst Classic Ink.
- 8. Stamp the leaves and stem in Lemon Lime Twist Classic Ink.
- 9. Then stamp the bow and sentiment in Bermuda Bay Classic Ink.
- 10. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of image and adhere over the ribbon.
