Assembly:

- 1. Adhere Basic Black card stock to card front.
- 2. Make sure your Basic Black Archival Ink is well inked. Stamp the sentiment along the bottom edge of completed technique panel and butterfly in center. Adhere to the card front. (You're Stamparatus is wonderful for this kind of thing since the Water Color Paper has some texture to it and you can stamp again without problems lining it up.)
- 3. Next stamp butterfly image using Basic Black Archival Ink onto Whisper White Card stock. Allow to dry.
- 4. Color butterfly in with Bermuda Bay and Pool Party Stampin' Blends as desired.
- 5. Cut butterfly out, don't worry about the antennas.
- 6. Then using Stampin' Dimensionals add the butterfly to the front over the top of the stamped image.
- 7. Stamp the inside panel and envelope as desired.
