

Easel Card tutorial

Supplies:

Simply Scored Board
Bone Folder
Tear & Tape or Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive

For Easel Card Base, you'll need:

Card stock: Cut $4\frac{1}{4}'' \times 11''$; scored at $2\frac{3}{4}''$ and $5\frac{1}{2}''$
Card stock: Cut $4\frac{1}{4}'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$

1. Pre-fold all score lines. First fold on the $2\frac{3}{4}''$ line and then the $5\frac{1}{2}''$ score line in opposite direction.



2. Place two lines of Tear & Tape on the longer edge of the $2\frac{3}{4}''$ section as shown.



3. Adhere the second piece of card stock to the first, lining up the short edges. This creates the easel card base.



4. Decorate as desired.



Tip: To make the easel card stand up an embellishment or layer must be added to the inside of card. It is best to have the layer/embellishment at least one third into the card (from the bottom).
