Assembly:

1. Add Crumb Cake Reinker to white paint. Mix well and paint frame with 2 coats. Allow to dry well.
2. Using your Stampin' Spritzer spritz frame with Copper Shimmer Mist. Allow to dry well. (See my How to Create Shimmer Mist Video Tutorial)
3. Begin stamping your tissue paper using the dots stamp image first using Crushed Curry, then Cajun Craze, Soft Suede and finally Merry Merlot Classic Inks.
4. Repeat the stamping process using the ring image, small leaf, large, leaf, 3 leaf image and small spiky leaf. Layering the images and colors as you go to fill the tissue paper as desired.
5. Ball the tissue paper up and open. Repeat 4 to 5 times so that you have a crinkled effect.
6. Fit the tissue paper to the frame making sure not to smooth the tissue paper out all the way. (The crinkles and creases add texture and are part of the Faux Silk Technique.)
7. Apply Multipurpose Liquid Glue to the frame and smooth out with foam paint brush. Allow to dry.
8. Place tissue paper onto frame and pat down making sure not to remove the wrinkling.
9. Cut an X in the center of the frame and wrap tissue paper around the opening.
10. Finally wrap tissue paper around the back of the frame and adhere with some more Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Trim if necessary.
11. Measure the wood frame and cut a piece of Crumb Cake card stock for the back. Cut your card stock about ½" smaller than measurements. (mine measured 6" x 7 ¾")
12. Take the piece of Crumb Cake card stock and use the insert of the frame to trace the center opening. Use your Paper Snips to remove the center piece.
13. Use a 1" Circle punch and punch out the center of the bottom portion to allow stand.
14. Adhere the Crumb Cake piece to the back of the frame to give it a clean look and cover the edges of the tissue paper.

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Continued:

To decorate:

1. Cut out the leaves using your Framelits dies of the Nature's Roots Framelits Dies first using the Cherry Cobbler card stock.
2. Repeat using Pumpkin Pie card stock and then Poppy Parade card stock.
3. Take your pieces and run them through the Big Shot again using the embossing dies and the Big Shot Embossing Mats.
4. Spritz leaves with Copper Shimmer Mist to add a bit of shimmer. Allow to dry.
5. Stamp your leaf image in Crushed Curry Classic Ink onto Very Vanilla card stock.
6. Then stamp your sentiment in Soft Suede Classic Ink.
7. Punch sentiment out using 1 3/4" Circle Punch.
8. Use a Stampin' Sponge to sponge edges of sentiment using Crushed Curry Classic Ink.
9. Begin building your focal point by adhering the leaves onto the corner of the frame with your Multipurpose Liquid Glue as desired.
10. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the sentiment and adhere to frame.
11. Add photo of your choice.
12. Enjoy!
