Whisper White Card stock: 2 ¾" x 1 ½"

Assembly:

1. Slide your piece of Whisper White card stock into the Everyday Label Punch. Start on the top of the punch and slide it through the left side of punch blades. (Lining up edge of card stock with edge of the punch.)
2. Stamp your sentiment onto to Whisper White card stock using the Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
3. Color the word Luck using the Light Call Me Clover Stampin' Blends.
4. Stamp your clover onto a scrap piece of Whisper White card stock.
5. Color the clover first with the Light Call Me Clover Stampin' Blends.
6. Then come back and outline the clover using the Dark Call Me Clover Stampin' Blends.
7. Punch out clover using the 1" Circle Punch.
8. Place the chocolate into the wrap about 1" down from the edge of the Happiness Blooms Designer Series Paper. Use a Mini Glue Dot to hold it in place.
9. Bring the bottom half of the wrap up and line up edges.
10. Staple the tag onto the wrap.
11. Take a piece of Gold Mini Sequin Trim and attach it to the tag using a Mini Glue Dot.
12. Add a Stampin' Dimensional to the back of the clover circle and adhere to the tag covering the staple and Sequin Trim. (This will also help hold the Sequin Trim in place.)
13. Give it to someone special!
