Gingham Gala Basket Tutorial

Gingham Gala Designer Series Paper: 6" x 6"; scored at 2" and 4" on both sides

Highland Heather Card stock: ¾" x 8 1/2" Whisper White Card stock: Cut 1/2" x 11"

Whisper White Card stock: scrap for punching Highland Heather Card stock: scrap for punching Metallic Brads: 2 of the same shape and size

Clear Faceted Gems: 1 large

Assembly:

- 1. Score Designer Series Paper at 2 and 4 inches.
- 2. Use your Paper Snips and cut on the score lines until they intersect on the top section and then the bottom section. (See video).
- 3. Next add a bit of adhesive on to the on the two outside flaps.
- 4. Bring up sides toward the center until the two panels make a point.
- 5. Repeat for other side.
- 6. Use the Detailed Trio Punch and punch the two corners on each end of the Highland Heather strip of card stock.
- 7. Use the Decorative Ribbon Border Punch and punch the Whisper White strip of card stock.
- 8. Adhere the Whisper White ribbon piece onto the Highland Heather card stock strip. Trim as needed.
- 9. Punch a hole each end of the layered strip using the 1/8" Handheld punch.
- 10. Punch a hole in each side of the basket using the 1/8" Handheld punch.
- 11. Add the handle to the basket using the Metallic Brads. (I placed the handle on the outside of the basket.)
- 12. Punch 3 daisies using the Whisper White card stock and Daisy Punch.
- 13. Curl the edges on one of the daisy pieces using your Bone Folder to put on the top of the stack.
- 14. Build your daisy by adhering the three daisies together.
- 15. Punch out a circle from the Highland Heather card stock using the ½" Circle Punch.
- 16. Adhere circle to center of layered daisies.
- 17. Add a Clear Faceted Gem to the center of the Highland Heather circle.
- 18. Place 2 Mini Stampin' Dimensionals on to the back of the daisy and adhere to the basket.
