Assembly:

1. Paint frame with 2 to 3 coats of white acrylic paint, allowing dry time between coats.
2. Using a Stampin' Sponge and Balmy Blue Classic Ink sponge frame randomly.
3. Stamp butterfly image using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad onto Whisper White card stock.
4. Color the large butterfly using Night of Navy Stampin' Blends Light on the outside edges and a bit in the center.
5. Then use the Pool Party Stampin' Blends Dark to create a band of color next to the Night of Navy and a bit more to the center of the butterfly.
6. Finally use the Balmy Blue Stampin' Blends Light to finish filling in the large butterfly.
7. For the small butterfly use the Bermuda Bay Stampin' Blends dark on the outside edges and a bit in the center.
8. Then use the Bermuda Bay Stampin' Blends Light to create a band of color next to the dark Bermuda Bay and the center too.
9. Finally use the Pool Party Stampin' Blends Light to finish filling in the small butterfly.
10. Punch out butterflies and stamp the bodies using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad.
11. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back, making sure to fill the area so they don't flex when placed on the frame.
12. Repeat steps 3 thru 11 about 10 to 12 times; or as many as desired.
13. Place butterflies on the frame spacing them out as desired. Make sure that some of the butterflies hang over the edges on the inside and outside of the frame to create the "floating frame" look.
14. Then working clockwise attach the large butterflies.
15. Next adhere the small butterflies.
16. Using your Paper Snips, cut the edges that are hanging over the frame off. First on the outside of frame and then the inside.
17. Place the image desired into your frame and give it to someone special!
