Sahara Sand Card stock: Cut 4 1/4" x 11"; scored at 2 ¾", and 5 1/2" and fold

Sahara Sand Card stock: Cut 4 ¼" x 5 ½"

Soft Suede Card stock: Cut (2) 4" x 5 1/4"

Night of Navy Card stock: Cut 2 7/8" x 3 3/8"

Real Red Card stock: Cut 2 1/8" x 3 1/8"

Sahara Sand Card stock: Cut 2 ½" x 3"

Real Red Card stock: Cut 4" x 3/4"

Night of Navy Card stock: Cut 4" x 1/2"

Sahara Sand Card stock: 4" by ½"
Sahara Sand Card stock: scrap for stamping
Night of Navy/Sahara Sand Baker's Twine: Cut 30"

Sailing Home Easel Card Tutorial

Assembly:

- 1. Create the Easel Card base using the Easel Card Tutorial (below) for folding instructions.
- 2. Stamp the 2 pieces of Soft Suede Card stock using the Soft Suede Classic Ink and the anchor and compass image. Stamping off for a softer feel.
- 3. Adhere pieces to the card front and the inside of the card.
- 4. Adhere the Night of Navy Card stock piece to the card front about ½ inch down from the top edge.
- 5. Wrap a piece of Night of Navy/Sahara Sand Baker's Twine around the bottom of the card front 3 times and tie into a knot. Trim ends as desired.
- 6. Stamp your boat image using the Night of Navy Classic Ink.
- 7. Quickly take your Blender Pen and run it over the water to blend it a bit.
- 8. Then using the Real Red Light Stampin' Blends color the boats hull.
- 9. Stamp the boat again onto a post it notes and cut out to create a mask.
- 10. Place the mask over the boat and stamp the sea gull image as desired using Night of Navy Classic Ink.
- 11. Layer the finished piece onto Real Red Card stock. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back.
- 12. Adhered layered boat images onto the card front Night of Navy layer.
- 13. For the inside of card adhere the Real Red strip of card stock about $1 \frac{1}{1}$ 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ up from the bottom edge.
- 14. Cut out the rope shape die using a piece of Sahara Sand Card stock. Adhere to Night of Navy card stock strip and trim off excess.
- 15. Adhere the layered Night of Navy piece on top of the Real Red layer.
- 16. Stamp the sentiment using Night of Navy Classic Ink and cut out shape using the die.
- 17. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back and adhere to the inside on top of the layered rope.
- 18. Add an anchor using Mini Glue Dots to the right of the sentiment.
- 19. Decorate the envelope as desired.

Easel Card tutorial

Supplies:

Simply Scored Board Bone Folder Tear & Tape or Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive For Easel Card Base, you'll need:

Card stock: Cut 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11"; scored at 2 $\frac{3}{2}$ " and 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Card stock: Cut 4 ¼" x 5 ½"

1. Pre-fold all score lines. First fold on the 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " line and then the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " score line in opposite direction.



2. Place two lines of Tear & Tape on the longer edge of the 2 ¾" section as shown.



3. Adhere the second piece of card stock to the first, lining up the short edges. This creates the easel card base.



Tip: To make the easel card stand up an embellishment or layer must be added to the inside of card. It is best to have the layer/embellishment at least one third into the card (from the bottom).
