

## To A Wild Rose July Thank You Card Tutorial



### Paper

Poppy Parade Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"  
Whisper White Card stock: Cut 3 1/2" x 5 1/2"  
Whisper White Card stock: Cut 3 1/4" x 1"  
Whisper White Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

### Supplies:

#### Stamps

To A Wild Rose (\*149453)

#### Paper

Poppy Parade Card stock (119793)  
Whisper White Card stock (100730)

#### Ink

Basic Gray Classic Ink (149165/149166)  
Poppy Parade Classic ink (147050/119791)  
Shaded Spruce Classic Ink (147088/147165)

#### Adhesives

Snail (104332/104331)  
Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

### Assembly:

1. Using the Poppy Parade Classic Ink stamp your rose image onto the center of the Whisper White card front panel. (I stamped off first to get a softer image.)
2. Then use the full rose image using the Poppy Parade Classic Ink. Stamp off twice before adding this layer to the first rose you stamped.
3. Finally using the Poppy Parade Classic Ink stamp the outline rose image.
4. Add the two sets of leaves using the Shaded Spruce Classic Ink and stamping off first. (You can use a post it to mask the rose if desired.)
5. Stamp the center of the flower using the Basic Gray Classic Ink.
6. Using the Whisper White card stock strip stamp the "Blessed" sentiment close to the left-hand edge of the card stock using Poppy Parade Classic Ink. You'll want to stamp off first to create a lighter shade.
7. Then use the Basic Gray Classic Ink to stamp the smaller sentiment of your choice on the right-hand lower edge of the card stock piece. The sentiments will overlap.
8. Adhere the sentiment using Stampin' Dimensionals on the lower portion of the rose as shown.
9. Stamp the Whisper White card stock panel with the rose outline image and Poppy Parade Classic Ink in the lower left-hand corner. Then add it to the inside of your card.
10. Stamp envelope as desired.
