Ribbon: Cut 22-24" Kit Kat Candy Bar: 1



Assembly:

- 1. Cut your holder by starting with the long edge; score at 3", 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", and 8".
- 2. Turn to the shorter edge and score at 2 ¼", 2 ¾", 5 ½", and 6".
- 3. Using your Paper Snips cut the score lines on the long side all the way up to where the second score line interests. Repeat on all the score lines along both of the long sides.
- 4. Then cut the short sides along the score lines; Cut the outside score line all the way up to the second intersection of score lines and cut the inside score lines up to where the first score line intersects. This will create a tab.
- 5. Repeat on the second short side.



- 6. Stamp the sentiment using the Pretty Peacock Classic Ink on to the Whisper White card stock piece.
- 7. Then adhere the sentient onto the Mint Macron Card stock piece.
- 8. Lay your Kit Kat bar into the holder. (This will create a firmer surface if you want to use your Snail adhesive).
- 9. Fold up the bottom flap and bring down the top flap.
- 10. Add some adhesive along the center of the flap edge.

Continued:

- 11. Then add adhesive to the back top 1/3 of the sentiment piece and adhere to the top flap. (This is an easy way to add adhesive so that you don't adhere the hole piece down onto of the bottom flap.)
- 12. Close the left flap and then the right flap (this is the back). Pay attention to the direction of your sentiment so that the front will be right side up for the next step.
- 13. Flip over and place a bit of Snail Adhesive down the center to hold your ribbon.
- 14. Lay your ribbon down to that equal on both sides. Adhere.
- 15. Tie your ribbon to the right side into a bow and trim ends as desired.
- 16. Emboss your Mint Macaron Card stock piece using the Stylish Scroll Embossing Folder.
- 17. Using your Multipurpose Adhesive adhere the embossed piece to the front of your holder.
- 18. Stamp the pitcher and flowers using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink onto the Whisper White Card stock piece.
- 19. Color your image using the Pretty Peacock Stampin' Blends for the pitcher.
- 20. Color the flowers and berries using the Cajun Craze Stampin' Blends.
- 21. Color the large circular flowers using the Dark Old Olive Stampin' Blends and the leaf below it using the Light Old Olive Stampin' Blends.
- 22. Finally color your leaves and stems using the Mint Macaron Stampin' Blends.
- 23. Cut out the pitcher using your oval Stitched Shapes Dies.
- 24. Then add the Snowfall Accents Puff Paint to the cotton pods. Heat with the Heat Tool until puffy. (Tip: Puff Paint is thin, so add it carefully and do not hold the Heat Tool too close to begin with. Bring it closer as the Puff Paint heats up to prevent splattering).
- 25. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the pitcher image and adhere to the front of the holder.
