

## Dragonfly Garden Easel Calendar Card Tutorial



### Paper

Mossy Meadow Card stock: Cut 4 1/4" x 11"; scored at 2 3/4" and 5 1/2"

Mossy Meadow Card stock: Cut 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"

Bumblebee Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 3 3/4" x 5"

Bumblebee Card Stock: Cut 3 1/8" x 2 3/8"

Whisper White Card stock: scrap for punching

Bumblebee Card stock: Cut 4" x 2 1/4"

Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper: Cut 4" x 2"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 4" x 1 3/4"

Whisper White Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

2x3" Mini Calendar: 1

Ladybug Trinkets: 1

## Dragonfly Garden Easel Calendar Card Tutorial

Continued:

1. Stamp the wildflower image using the Mossy Meadow Classic Ink onto the left side of the Whisper White card stock panel.
2. Using the strip of Whisper White card stock stamp the wild flower image using Mossy Meadow Classic Ink on the left side about 1/2 inch in from the edge.
3. Then stamp the sentiment to the right of the wildflower image using Mossy Meadow Classic Ink.
4. Stamp the dragonfly (solid body) onto scrap piece of Whisper White card stock piece using the Mossy Meadow Classic Ink.
5. Next using the Bumblebee Classic Ink up the wing image, stamp off first and then stamp again onto the dragonfly's wings.
6. Add a bit of Clear Wink of Stella onto the dragonfly's wings.
7. Punch out Dragonfly image using the Dragonflies Punch.
8. To begin building the card front, adhere the Bumblebee Card stock panel to the Mossy Meadow Card stock piece.
9. Then adhere down the stamped panel onto the Bumblebee layer.
10. Adhere the Bumblebee Card stock piece to the lower right-hand corner as a mat for the calendar.
11. Then adhere the calendar onto the Bumblebee layer using Tear & Tape or Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
12. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the dragonfly and adhere it to the area above the calendar as desired.
13. Fold the long Mossy Meadow card base first on the center score line and then again back towards itself on the second score line to create a Z fold. (See video link above).
14. Adhere the finished assembled card front panel to the top section of the card base to create the easel base as shown.
15. Adhere the Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper strip onto the Bumblebee Card stock strip.
16. Then adhere the sentiment strip onto the Dandy Garden Designer Series Paper.
17. Add Stampin' Dimensionals onto the back of the layered sentiment piece. Adhere it down centered about 1/4" up from the bottom (as shown) on the inside of the card base.
18. Using a Mini Glue Dot add the Ladybug Trinket to the left of the sentiment as desired.
19. To create a signature panel for the back stamp the dragonfly (solid body) onto a panel of Whisper White card stock in the lower right-hand corner using the Mossy Meadow Classic Ink.
20. Next using the Bumblebee Classic Ink, ink up the wing image, stamp off first and then stamp again onto the dragonfly's wings.
21. Add a bit of Clear Wink of Stella onto the dragonfly's wings.
22. Adhere onto the back of card.
23. Stamp the envelope as desired.
