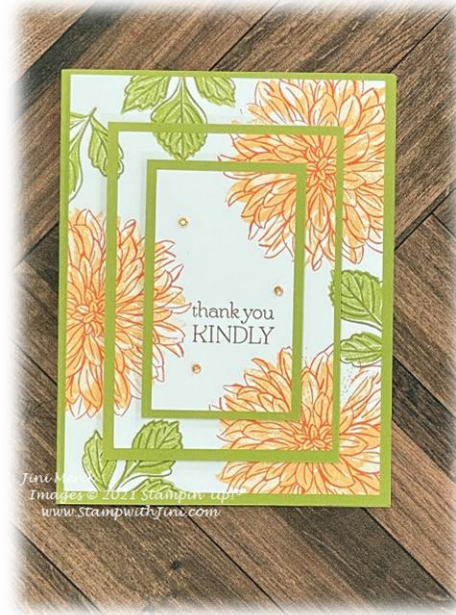


Delicate Dahlias Triple Stamping Card Tutorial



Paper

Old Olive Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4" and folded

Basic White card stock: Cut 4 " x 5 1/4"

Old Olive Card stock: Cut 3" x 4 1/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 2 3/4" x 4"

Old Olive Card stock: Cut 2" x 3 1/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 1 3/4" x 3"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4 " x 4"

Champagne Rhinestones: 3 assorted

Assembly:

1. Layer your 3 pieces of Basic White card stock together with a dab of Stampin' Seal adhesive. (Touching the Stampin' Seal with your finger several times will help make the Stampin' Seal be less sticky.)
2. Using the Pale Papaya Classic Ink stamp 4 dahlias onto the Basic White card stock piece randomly. (Make sure to leave the center of the Basic White card stock empty so you can stamp the sentiment in step 6.)
3. Stamp the 2-step dahlia image using Calypso Coral Classic Ink.
4. Next using the Pear Pizzazz Classic Ink stamp the leaves randomly around roses.
5. Stamp the 2-step leaf image using Old Olive Classic Ink.
6. Now stamp the sentiment onto Basic White card stock using Early Espresso Classic Ink.
7. Carefully pull the layers apart and set them aside.
8. To begin take the largest floral piece and adhere to card front.
9. Then add the largest layer of Old Olive Card stock onto the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Adhere the second largest floral piece to the Old Olive layer, paying attention so that the images line up.
11. Now adhere the sentiment piece to the smallest Old Olive card stock layer.
12. Adhere layered sentiment to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
13. Stamp inside Basic White panel as desired and adhere.
14. Stamp envelope as desired.
