Assembly:

- 1. Stamp the sentiment onto the wood grain side of the Hearts & Home Designer Series Paper strip using Cinnamon Cider Classic Ink.
- 2. Using the Fresh Freesia Card stock cut out 3 flower images using the flower die and your Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
- 3. Using the Cinnamon Cider Card stock cut out the swag image 2 times using the swag die and your Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
- 4. Adhere the 2 Cinnamon Cider swags in the center of the Heart & Home Designer Series Paper panel as shown.
- 5. Adhere the Heart & Home Designer Series Paper to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the layered panel and adhere to the center of the card front.
- 7. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to each end of the sentiment and adhere over the center of the flower image on the card front.
- 8. Adhere the 3 Fresh Freesia flowers as desired onto the card front.
- 9. Using your Take Your Pick Tool add some Classic Matte Dots on and around the flower images as shown.
- 10. Stamp inside Basic White panel as desired.
- 11. Stamp envelope as desired.
