Gingham Cottage Designer Series Paper: Cut 2 1/4" x 12" Mint Macaron Card stock: Cut 2 ¼" x 8 ½"; scored at 1/4" and 2" on long side, turn score at 3 ½ and 5" Mint Macaron Card stock: Cut (2) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Real Red Card stock: Cut 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" Basic White Card stock: Cut 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" Gingham Cottage Designer Series Paper: scrap for punching Real Red 3/8" Ribbon: Cut 18-20"

Christmas Scottie Treat Box

Assembly:

- 1. Create the box with Mint Macaron Card stock as shown.
- 2. Create outside holder for the box using the Handmade Tag Punch and the Gingham Cottage Designer Series Paper by sliding it into the punch from the top lining up the edge with the punch as shown in the video.
- 3. Wrap it around the bottom of the box, lining up and punching the top together lightly while you run your fingers on each side of the box to crease.
- 4. Remove the Designer Series Paper and fold on the "scored" lines to create a sharp fold.
- 5. Adhere the box to the inside of the Designer Series Paper between the scored lines only. Set aside for step 14.
- 6. Stamp the Scottie image onto the Basic White Card using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad.
- 7. Stamp the sentiment above the dog using Real Red Classic Ink.
- 8. Cut out the sentiment piece using the Layering Circles Dies and Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
- 9. Cut a coordinating scallop circle using Real Red Card stock and the Layering Circle Dies.
- 10. Punch the bow using Gingham Cottage Designer Series Paper using the Scottie Dog Punch.
- 11. Adhere the sentiment circle onto the scallop circle.
- 12. Adhere the layered sentiment piece to the front of the box wrap.
- 13. Adhere the bow onto the Scottie's neck using a Stampin' Dimensional.
- 14. Wrap a piece of Real Red Mini Ribbon around the treat box and tie into a bow below the Scottie dog. Adjust as desired and trim ends.
- 15. Fill your treat as desired.
