Paper

Basic White Thick Card stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Subtles Collection Designer Series Paper (Balmy blue pattern): Cut 5 1/4" x 3"

Basic White Card stock: 3" x 3 3/4"

Real Red Card stock: 3" x 3 3/4"

Window Sheet: 3" x 3 3/4"

Basic Black Card stock: piece for punching

Basic White Card stock: piece for punching

Pumpkin Pie Card stock: piece for punching

Real Red 3/8" Mini Ruffled Ribbon: Cut 18-20"

Sparkle & Shine Sequins Assortment: "pinch or two"

Continued:

1. Punch the tummy of the penguin from Basic White Card stock using the Penguin Builder Punch.
2. Punch the body of the penguin's using Basic Black Card stock.
3. Punch 2 feet using Pumpkin Pie Card stock and the Penguin Builder Punch.
4. Stamp the eyes onto the penguin's Basic White piece using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
5. Stamp the beak onto the penguin's face using Pumpkin Pie Classic Ink.
6. Adhere the face to the body of the penguin.
7. Using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals add the feet to the penguin. Set aside for step 21.
8. Stamp the sentiment using Real Red Classic Ink onto Basic White Card stock.
9. Cut your sentiment out using the larger Oval Frame Die and your Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
10. Using the smaller frame die cut another oval frame out of Real Red Card stock.
11. Using a piece of Window Sheet cut one of the larger decorative oval dies. Run through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss several times to make sure you have a clean cut. Or finish cutting with your Paper Snips. (You'll only need the center oval for this project).
12. Using your Blending Brush add some color around the edge of the oval with Balmy Blue Classic Ink.
13. Using the Foam Adhesive Strips add adhesive around the edge of the oval.
14. Add some of the Sparkle & Shine Sequins as desired.
15. Remove protecting backing on the Foam Strips and adhere the Window Sheet Oval down on top of the adhesive.
16. Then using Mini Glue Dots add the Real Red frame to top of the Window Sheet lining up edges carefully.
17. Turn shaker frame over and add several strips of Tear & Tape down the back. Set aside for step 19.
18. Adhere the Subtles Designer Series Paper to the bottom of the Basic White Card stock panel.

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Assembly Continued:

19. Wrap a piece of Real Red Mini Ruffled Ribbon around the layered panel and tie a bow. Trim ends as desired and move the bow to the left side of the panel.
20. Remove the protective layer from the shaker frame and adhere to the right side of the card front.
21. Adhere the penguin to the left side of the shaker oval as shown.
22. Stamp inside panel as desired.
23. Stamp envelope as desired.

Tip: Use your Embossing Buddy to knock down the sticky on the sides of the Foam Adhesive Strips. You can also use the Embossing Buddy to remove static from the shaker frame as you assemble. Be careful to not add too much that it shows or doesn't allow the adhesive strips to adhere.
