Vintage Tool Easel Card Tutorial





Paper

Basic Black Card stock: Cut 5 ½" x 8 ½"; scored at 2 1/8" and 4 ¼"

Basic Black Card stock: Cut 5 ½" x 4 ½" Crumb Cake Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4" Basic Black Card stock: Cut 4" x 2 1/2"

Neutrals Collection Designer Series Paper (Early Espresso): Cut 3 3/4" x 2 1/4"

Basic Black Card stock: for punching

Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut (3) 1 1/8" x 1 3/4"

Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 3" x ½"
Crumb Cake Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"
Basic Black Card stock: Cut 5" x 1 ¾"
Very Vanilla Card stock: Cut 4 ¾" x 1 ½"

Rustic Metallic Adhesive Baked Dots: 7 assorted

Assembly:

- 1. Stamp the plyers, clamp, and awl with nails images onto each of the 3 Very Vanilla Card stock panels using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad as shown.
- 2. Stamp the sentiment onto Very Vanilla Card stock panel using Early Espresso Classic Ink.
- 3. Stamp the tool and nail images onto sentiment panel on the as shown using Memento Black Ink Pad.
- 4. Run the two panels of Crumb Cake Card Stock through the Timber 3D Embossing Folder and Your Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
- 5. Using your Blending Brush and Early Espresso Classic Ink add color to the outside edge around each of the tool panels. Also add some color around the inside sentiment panel.
- 6. Using your Blending Brush and Early Espresso Classic Ink add color to the outside edge around each of the Timber Embossed panels.
- 7. Stamp the sentiment onto to the strip of Very Vanilla Card stock using Early Espresso Classic Ink.
- 8. Use your Paper Snips to cut a flag on each end of the sentiment panel.
- 9. Adhere the Timber Embossed panel to the Basic Black 5 ½" x 4 ¼" card front.
- 10. Adhere the Early Espresso Designer Series Paper to the Basic Black Card stock panel.
- 11. Adhere the layered panel to the center of the card front about ½ to ¾ inches down from the top.
- 12. Punch the Basic Black Card stock using the Rectangular Postage Stamp Punch 3 times.
- 13. Adhere each of the stamped tool images to the 3 punched pieces.
- 14. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to each of the layered tool pieces and adhere them across the front of the card as shown.
- 15. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the sentiment and adhere it down the center of the 3 images.
- 16. Fold the long Basic Black card base first on the center score line and then again back towards itself on the second score line to create a Z fold. (See video link above).
- 17. Using Tear & Tape adhere the finished assembled card front panel to the top section of the card base to create the easel base as shown.
- 18. Adhere the Adhere the Timber Embossed panel to the Basic Black inside panel.
- 19. Adhere the sentiment panel to the Basic Black Card stock panel.
- 20. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the layered sentiment panel and adhere to the inside Timber panel leaving the same margin around all 3 sides to hold the card front up and create the easel.
- 21. Using your Take Your Pick Tool add 3 assorted Rustic Metallic Adhesive Backed Dots to the tool panels as desired.
- 22. Then add 4 more Rustic Metallic Adhesive Backed Dot along the inside sentiment panel.
- 23. Optional: Stamp a 5 ¼" x 4" Very Vanilla Card stock panel as desired and adhere to the backside of the card if desired for a signature panel.
- 24. Decorate your Very Vanilla Envelope as desired.
