

Vintage Tool Calendar Card Tutorial



Paper

Cherry Cobbler Card stock: Cut 11" x 4 1/4"; scored at 4 1/4, 8 1/2, 9 1/2", and 10 1/2"

Sahara Sand Card stock: Cut 4" x 4"

Rustic Metallic Adhesive Baked Dots: 4 small

2"x3" Mini Calendar

Cherry Cobbler Card stock (119685)

Sahara Sand Card stock (121043)

Early Espresso Classic Ink

Assembly:

1. Using the Blending Brush and Early Espresso Classic Ink add color around the outside of the Sahara Sand Card stock.
2. Stamp the sentiment onto antiqued Card stock panel using Early Espresso Classic Ink in the upper left-hand corner as shown.
3. Then stamp hammer image using Early Espresso Classic Ink.
4. Fold the long Cherry Cobbler card base first on the center score line and then again back towards itself on the second and third score line to create a Z fold. (See video link above).
5. Add Tear & Tape along the bottom ½" edge. Remove backing and adhere to the front flap as shown to create the tent. (The seam will be the back of your Calendar Card.)
6. Add Tear & Tape along the back of the sentiment panel and the calendar.
7. Adhere the finished stamped card front panel to the card base as shown.
8. Adhere the calendar below the hammer on the front panel.
9. Using your Take Your Pick Tool add 4 small Rustic Metallic Adhesive Backed Dots to the tool panel in the top and bottom corners.
10. Optional: Stamp a 4" x 4" Card stock panel as desired and adhere to the backside of the card if desired for a signature panel.
11. Decorate your Envelope as desired.
