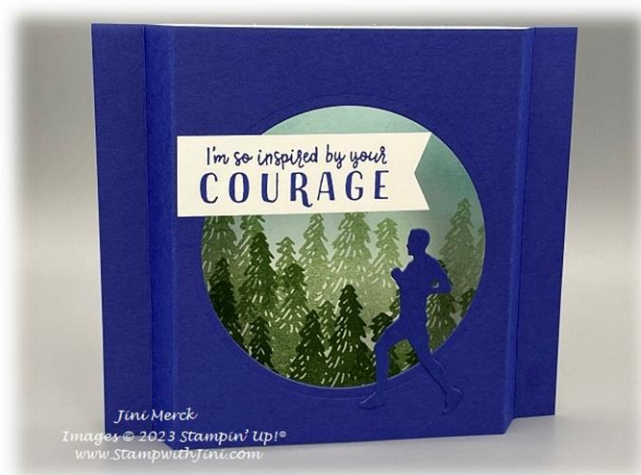


## Greatest Journey Courage Shadow Box Card

Starry Sky Card stock: Cut 5 ½" x 4 1/4"; scored at ½, 1, 4 ½, and 5"

Basic White Thick Card stock: Cut 5 ½" x 4 1/4"; scored at ½, 1, 4 ½, and 5"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 1 1/2" x 3"

Starry Sky Card stock: piece for die cutting

Basic White Card stock: Cut 3 1/4" x 4"

## Greatest Journey Courage Shadow Box Card

### Assembly:

1. Punch the right end of the Basic White Card stock strip using the Banner Pick a Punch.
2. Stamp the sentiment onto the Basic White Card stock using Starry Sky Classic Ink.
3. Using your Blending Brush and Coastal Cabana Classic Ink add color to the top of the Basic White inside panel.
4. Using your Blending Brush and Garden Green Classic Ink add color to the bottom of the Basic White inside panel.
5. Then using the Garden Green Classic Ink and pine tree image stamp the trees along the bottom randomly.
6. Next, using the grass image Garden Green Classic Ink use the stamp off method to create a second and third row of trees randomly along the bottom as shown.
7. Die Cut the shape between the score lines on the Starry Sky Card stock panel.
8. Die the runner from the Starry Sky Card stock piece from step 7.
9. Lay your card front onto the back piece to see where you would like the sentiment banner to be. Adhere on the side onto left side of the card front being careful not the let adhesive get onto the back panel.
10. Then adhere the runner as desired, being careful not the let adhesive get onto the back panel.
11. To assemble. Fold the score lines with a Bone Folder a couple of times on both the card front and the card back pieces.
12. Add Tear & Tape along the first score line on the stamped side of the card back as shown.
13. Remove the Tear & Tape protective strip on each side and adhere the front to the back.

Tip: Stamp Off technique will give you different shades of color using the same Ink pad.
