Basic White Thick Card stock: Cut 5 ½" x 8 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Basic Gray Card stock: Cut 1 1/4" x 2"

Basic Gray Card stock: Cut ½" x 1 ½"

Adhesive Sheet: Cut ½" x 1 ½"

Assembly:

1. Using your Stampin' Cut & Emboss along with the Greatest Journey Die Cuts create a mask using Sticky Notes and the 3 cloud dies, and Mountain die.
2. Add the cloud masks to the top of the card front.
3. Using your Blending Brush and Balmy Blue Classic Ink add color to the top of the Basic White panel. Remove Masks.
4. Then add the mountain mask to the bottom of the card front.
5. Using your Blending Brush and Cajun Craze Classic Ink add color. Move the mask and repeat a second time. Repeat until you reach desired look.
6. Cut the Center Flap Card as per the Video Tutorial.
7. Adhere the two small flaps down on the left and right.
8. Using the Basic Gray Classic Ink stamp the inside sentiment onto Basic White Card stock under the flap.
9. Using Basic Gray Card stock run the hiker die through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
10. Add the Adhesive Sheet onto the smaller strip of Basic Gray Card stock and cut out the walking stick die shape.
11. Next, cut off the lantern off the hiker shape using your Paper Snips and then adhere the hiker onto the left side of the front flap as desired.
12. Remove the Adhesive Sheet backing and adhere the walking stick onto the hiker's hand.
13. Stamp your envelope if desired.
