### Paper

Coastal Cabana Card stock: Cut 9 1/2" x 4 1/4"; scored at 1/2, 1 1/2, 3 and 4"  
Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper (pattern 1): Cut 5 1/4" x 4" and 1 1/4" x 4"  
Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper (pattern 1): Cut 1 1/4" x 4"  
Petal Pink Card stock: Cut 5" x 3"; scored at 3 1/2" and 4 1/2"  
Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper (pattern 2): Cut 3 1/4" x 2 3/4"  
Basic White Card stock: piece for die cutting  
Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper (pattern 3): piece for cutting out flower  
Basic White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"  
Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper (pattern 1): Cut 3/4" x 4"  
Opaque Adhesive Backed Gems (Melon Mambo): 5 assorted

## Something Fancy Birthday Box Card Tutorial

Continued:

1. Stamp large sentiment using Early Espresso Classic Ink onto Basic White Card stock.
2. Die cut sentiment out using the Something Fancy Die and your Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
3. Adhere the Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper to the large section of the card base.
4. Fold the card base and Using Tear & Tape create the box as shown in the video tutorial.
5. Adhere the strip of Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper to the larger section of the second panel.
6. Using Tear & Tape adhere the left side to the top of the box and then the right side to the card base as shown in the video tutorial.
7. Adhere the sentiment to the center of the panel.
8. Using your Paper Snips cut out a small flower and use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere it to the sentiment panel.
9. Using your Take your Pick Tool add Opaque Adhesive Backed Gems as desired.
10. Stamp Basic White Card stock panel as desired and use the Early Espresso Classic Ink.
11. Adhere down the strip of Hues of Happiness Designer Series Paper to the left edge as shown.
12. Adhere the finished panel to the back of the card.
13. Stamp envelope as desired.
