Flirty Flamingo Card Stock: Cut 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 4 1/2" x 4 1/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 3 1/2" x 3/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 5 1/4" x 4"

Balmy Blue & White 1/2" Variegated Ribbon: Cut 4"

Iridescent Rhinestone Basic Jewels: 3-5 assorted

## Textured Floral Card Tutorial

Assembly:

1. Stamp the sentiment using Pretty Peacock Classic Ink onto the Basic White Card stock strip.
2. Stamp the large flower using Flirty Flamingo Classic Ink in the left-hand side of the Basic White Card stock panel.
3. Stamp the buds using Lemon Lolly Classic Ink to the right of the large flower.
4. Stamp the leaves and the 2-step stem using Old Olive Classic Ink as shown.
5. Stamp the small flower and the stamen for the large flower using Cajun Craze Classic Ink.
6. Adhere the stamped floral panel to the card front.
7. Add the Ribbon to the back of the top of the sentiment strip. Trim ends as desired. Add Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Adhere your sentiment panel onto the card front as desired.
9. Using your Take Your Pick Tool add 3-5 Iridescent Rhinestones to the card front randomly as desired.
10. Stamp the envelope as desired.
