

Bee My Valentine Skinny Milk Box Tutorial

Bee Mine Designer Series Paper: Cut 6" x 6"
Daffodil Delight Card stock: scraps for stamping
Vellum Card stock: scraps for stamping
Basic White Card stock: scrap for punching
Sweet Sorbet ¼" Bordered Ribbon: Cut 8-10"
Burt's Bees Lip Balm

Assembly:

1. Score the Bee Mine Designer Series Paper at 1 ¼", 2 ½", 3 ¾", and 5"; then turn and score at 4 ¾" (If directional this score line goes on the bottom of your project; See video)
2. Assemble as shown in the video by cutting score lines along the bottom edge until they intersect.
3. Fold on score lines and use Bone Folder to make lines sharp. Add Adhesive along the smaller section edge and adhere the larger flap to it. (See video).
4. Making sure to fold in the back flap first so that you have a clean look on the front, adhere the bottom flaps by adhere one onto the next until the bottom is closed.
5. Stamp the wings onto Vellum Card stock using Daffodil Delight Classic Ink. Repeat. Allow images to dry well.
6. Stamp the antennae using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink onto Vellum Card stock. Allow images to dry well.
7. Stamp the Bee using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink onto Daffodil Delight Card stock.
8. Punch out an oval using the Double Oval Punch and Basic White Card stock.
9. Stamp small flower using Pool Party Classic Ink onto Basic White Card stock oval. (Fold first if you want to see exactly where to stamp.)
10. Punch out bee and wings using the Bee Builder Punch.
11. Using your Paper Snips but out antennae.
12. Adhere the wings and antennae to the bee as shown using Mini Glue Dots.
13. Fill the Skinny Milk Box with Lip Balm.
14. Pleat the top of the Skinny Milk Box by pushing in on both sides and squeezing as shown.
15. Fold the stamped oval over the top and staple the oval in place.
16. Tie a piece of Sweet Sorbet ¼" Bordered Ribbon into a small bow. Trim ends.
17. Using a Mini Glue Dot adhere bow to the top of the Milk Box to cover staple.
18. Add adhesive to the back of the bee and adhere to the front of the Milk Box as desired.
