### **Paper**

Sweet Sorbet Card stock: Cut 7 7/8" x 9 1/4"; scored at 1/2", 1 1/4", 4 7/8", and 5 1/2"

Bee Mine Designer Series Paper: Cut 3/4" x 7 7/8"

Basic White Card stock: Cut (2) 3" x 7 7/8" Basic White Card stock: piece for punching Petal Pink Card stock: piece for punching Sweet Sorbet ¼" Bordered Ribbon: 25-28"

# Assembly:

- 1. Stamp the two wings using Petal Pink Classic Ink onto Petal Pink Card stock.
- 2. Stamp the Bee's body using Daffodil Delight and Memento Tuxedo Black Ink onto Basic White card stock.
- 3. Stamp the antennas onto scrap Basic White Card stock (body piece) using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
- 4. Punch out the wings, antennas, and bee using the Bee Builder Punch.
- 5. Then using Memento Tuxedo black Ink stamp the bee's face as desired.
- 6. Assemble the Bee by placing a bit of adhesive to the point on the wings and antennas.
- 7. Repeat to create two more bees paying attention to the direction you want them to fly.
- 8. Stamp the sentiment onto the Basic White Card stock about 4 inches up from the bottom using Sweet Sorbet Classic Ink.
- 9. Stamp the small hearts and multiple hearts images randomly onto the panel using Pool Party Classic Ink.
- 10. Then stamp the "flight" image using Pool Party Classic Ink.
- 11. Next using your Blending Brush add Pool Party Classic Ink to the panel behind where each of the bees will go.
- 12. To create the signature panel for the back panel. Stamp the sentiment using Sweet Sorbet Classic Ink.
- 13. Then stamp the hearts in the upper left hand and bottom right-hand corners of the panel as desired.
- 14. Next stamp your Bee's body using Daffodil Delight and Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
- 15. Add the wings and antenna using the Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
- 16. Using the Blending Brush and Pool Party Classic Ink add color around the outside of the panel.

Assembly continued:

- 17. Lay Sweet Sorbet Stock on the Simply Scored Scoring Tool with the 7 7/8" along the top and score at ½", 1 ¼", 4 7/8", and 5 1/2". See my Video Tutorial for detailed instructions.)
- 18. With the 1/2 " section on the left, fold on score lines and add a piece of Sticky Strip to the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and back edge of the 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " section. Fold over and adhere. (See my Video Tutorial for detailed instructions.)
- 19. To decorate the slider, adhere the 2 pieces of Bee Mine Designer Series Paper onto the front of the Sweet Sorbet slider lining them up with the right and left edge.
- 20. Adhere finished panel to the front of the slider.
- 21. Then using Stampin' Dimensionals add the bees to the front panel.
- 22. Adhere the signature panel to the back.
- 23. Using a 1/4" hole in the top of the slider. First on the top and then on the back. (See video tutorial)
- 24. Take a piece of Sweet Sorbet ¼" Bordered Ribbon and run it through both holes.
- 25. Place your candy bar into the slider, pushing the ribbon down as you go. Tie ribbon into a bow and trim ends.

Tip: Decorate your slider first so that the holes are punched through all the layers and the ribbon will go through all the layers.
