Basic White Thick Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Bee Mine Designer Series Paper (pattern 1): Cut 3 3/4" x 1 3/4"

Bee Mine Designer Series Paper (pattern 2): Cut 3 3/4" x 3"

Pool Party Card stock: Cut 3 3/4" x 1"

Basic White Card stock: piece for punching

Adhesive Backed Hearts & Flowers: 3-5 assorted

Assembly:

1. Stamp the sentiment onto Pool Party Card stock using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink on the left side.
2. Using the stamp off method and “movement” image stamp along the top of the sentiment panel turning the stamp in order to create a long line.
3. Repeat again along the bottom of the sentiment panel.
4. Stamp the wings onto Basic White Card stock using Pool Party Classic Ink.
5. Then using the Water Painter and some reinker or ink in the lid of your stamp pad add color to the wings. Allow to dry.
6. Stamp the bee’s body using Daffodil Delight Classic Ink onto the Basic White Card stock.
7. Stamp the bee’s body using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
8. Then stamp the antenna onto Basic White Card stock.
9. Punch out bee pieces using the Bee Builder Punch.
10. Stamp bee’s face onto the body using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
11. Assemble bee as desired.
12. Adhere the 2 pieces of Bee Mine Designer Series Paper onto the Basic White Card stock placing one at the top and one along the bottom edges.
13. Adhere the punched Sweet Sorbet Decorative Circle to the card front.
14. Adhere the sentiment panel down the center between the Designer Series Paper pieces as desired.
15. Attach the layered panel onto the card front using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
16. Using Stampin’ Dimensionals attach bee to the card front to the right of the sentiment.
17. Using your Take Your Pick Tool add 3-5 Hearts & Flowers as desired to the sentiment and card front.
18. Stamp the inside Basic White panel as desired and adhere.
19. Stamp envelope as desired.

Tip: When using your ink pad lid as a pallet for water coloring, make sure there isn’t too much water on the lid when you close the pad. If the water gets onto the ink pad it can create a spot where the ink has been diluted.
