

## Construction Zone Birthday Card Tutorial



### Paper

Basic White Thick Card stock: Cut 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"; scored at 4 1/4"

Delightfully Eclectic Designer Series Paper (polka dots): Cut 2" x 5 1/2"

Smoky Slate Card stock: Cut 1/2" x 5 1/2"

Smoky Slate Card stock: Cut 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"

Crushed Curry Card stock: Cut 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut (4) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Assembly:

1. Stamp the sentiment using Poppy Parade Classic Ink onto the Basic White square at the top.
2. Stamp the arrow below the sentiment using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink.
3. On each of the Basic White Card stock squares stamp the little construction man, cement truck, and fork lift using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad.
4. Then stamp the present onto the fork lift using Memento Tuxedo black Ink Pad.
5. Stamp the cone in the lower right corner inside the card base using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad.
6. Color the construction man, fork lift, gift, cement truck, and road cone using Medium Light, Daffodil Delight, and Poppy Parade Stampin' Blends.
7. Adhere the strip of Designer Series Paper to the Basic White Thick Card base on the left side.
8. Then adhere the strip of Smoky Slate Card stock to the right of the Designer Series Paper.
9. Adhere the Smokey Slate Card stock panel to the center of the card front.
10. Adhere the 4 squares onto the Crushed Curry Card stock panel.
11. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the layered panel and adhere to the card front.
12. Stamp the inside card as desired.
13. Stamp envelope as desired.
