Assembly:

1. Stamp the sentiment using Pretty Peacock Classic Ink below the center of the Basic White Card stock panel on the right-hand side as shown.
2. Using Berry Burst Classic Ink stamp the large flower image randomly 3 times around the outside edge of the Basic White Card stock panel.
3. Using the Calypso Coral Classic Ink stamp the rose image 3 times around the outside edge of the panel.
4. Use the Lost Lagoon Classic Ink stamp some leaves randomly around the outside edge and between the flowers.
5. Use the Crushed Curry Classic Ink to stamp the small tri-flower image 3 times around the panel.
6. Finally using the stamp off technique and the Lost Lagoon Classic Ink and stamp some dots randomly around the outside edge and between the flowers.
7. Adhere the sentiment panel to the Pretty Peacock card stock panel.
8. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the back of the layered sentiment panel and adhere to the card front.
9. Using your Take Your Pick Tool add 5 assorted Iridescent Pearl Basic Jewels to the card front as desired.
10. Stamp the inside Basic White Card stock panel as desired and adhere to the inside of the card.
11. Stamp the envelope as desired.
