Full of Life Designer Series Paper: Cut (3) 3 1/2" x 1 1/2" Granny Apple Green Card stock: Cut 4 1/4" x 2 3/4"

Basic White Card stock: Cut 4" x 2 3/4" Basic White Card stock: Cut 4" x 5 1/4"

Iridescent Adhesive Backed Discs: 5-7 assorted

# Assembly:

- 1. Color the sentiment image using the Granny Apple Green and Berry Burst Stampin' Write Markers as shown. Tip: Use the side of the flair tip end.
- 2. Stamp the sentiment onto Basic White Card stock after "Huffing" on it.
- 3. Cut the sentiment out using the Countryside Corners Die and your Stampin' Cut & Emboss.
- 4. Cut a coordinating label shape using the Granny Apple Green card stock and the Stampin' Cut and Emboss.
- 5. Adhere the strips of Full of Life Designer Series Paper to the Berry Burst Card stock panel. (Make sure they go in order if desired)
- 6. Adhere the layered panel to the card front.
- 7. Adhere the sentiment to the Granny Apple Green Label.
- 8. Adhere the label to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Add 5-7 of the Discs using your Take Your Pick Tool to the around the card front and sentiment panel.
- 10. Stamp the inside sentiment panel if desired.
- 11. Adhere the inside stamped panel to the inside of the card.
- 12. Decorate your Basic White Envelope as desired.
